Program-specific career placement information can be found on the individual program homepages at www.ipr.edu.</p> <p>The employment rate in 2017 for this campus is 71%. This is based on a cohort of 118 full-time students available for graduation between January and December of 2014, and a cohort of 102 part-time students available for graduation between October 2011 and September 2012. Of these students, 105 graduated within 150% of normal time, 86 were available for employment and 61 of those available were employed in-field.</p>
